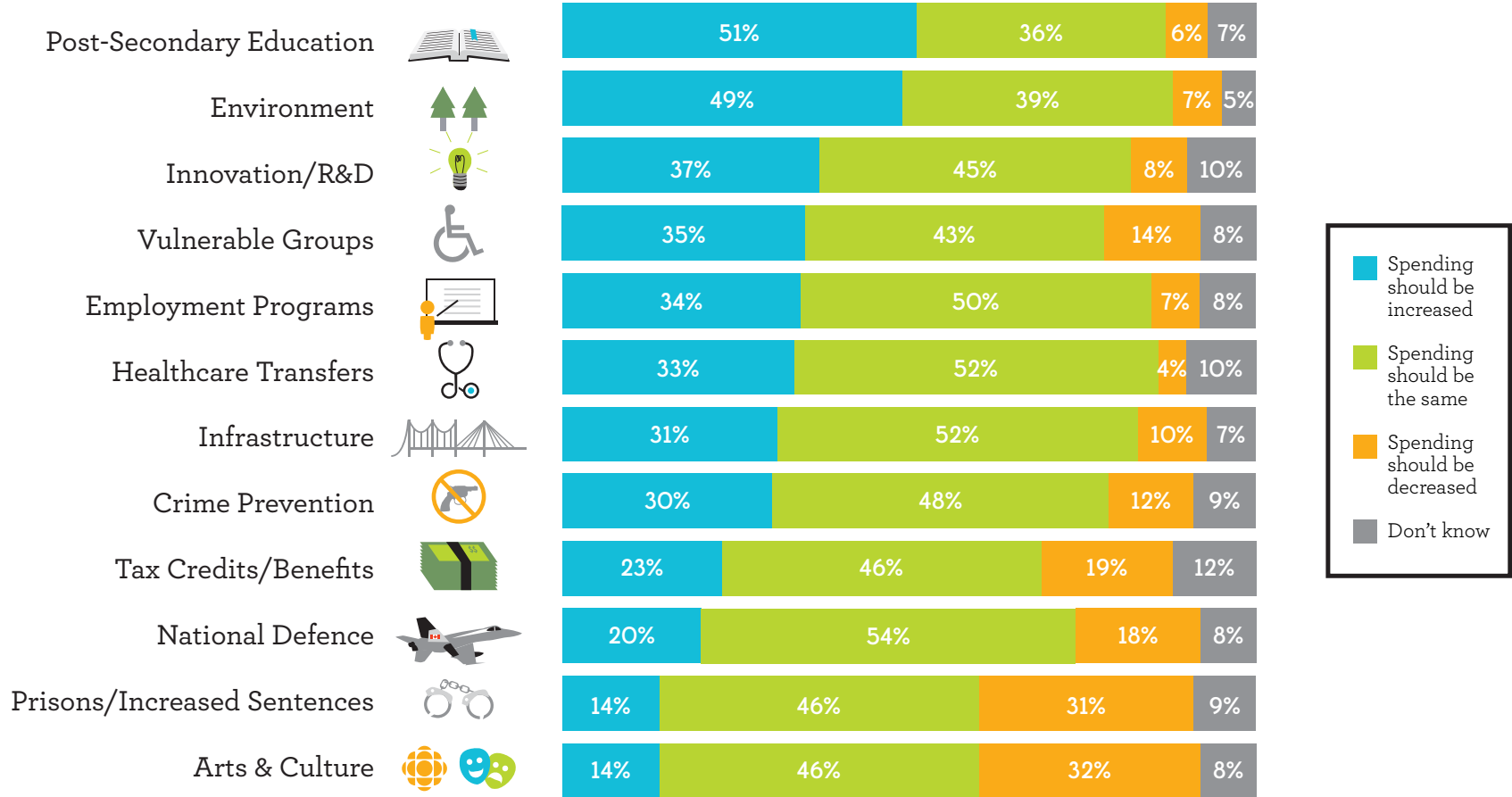

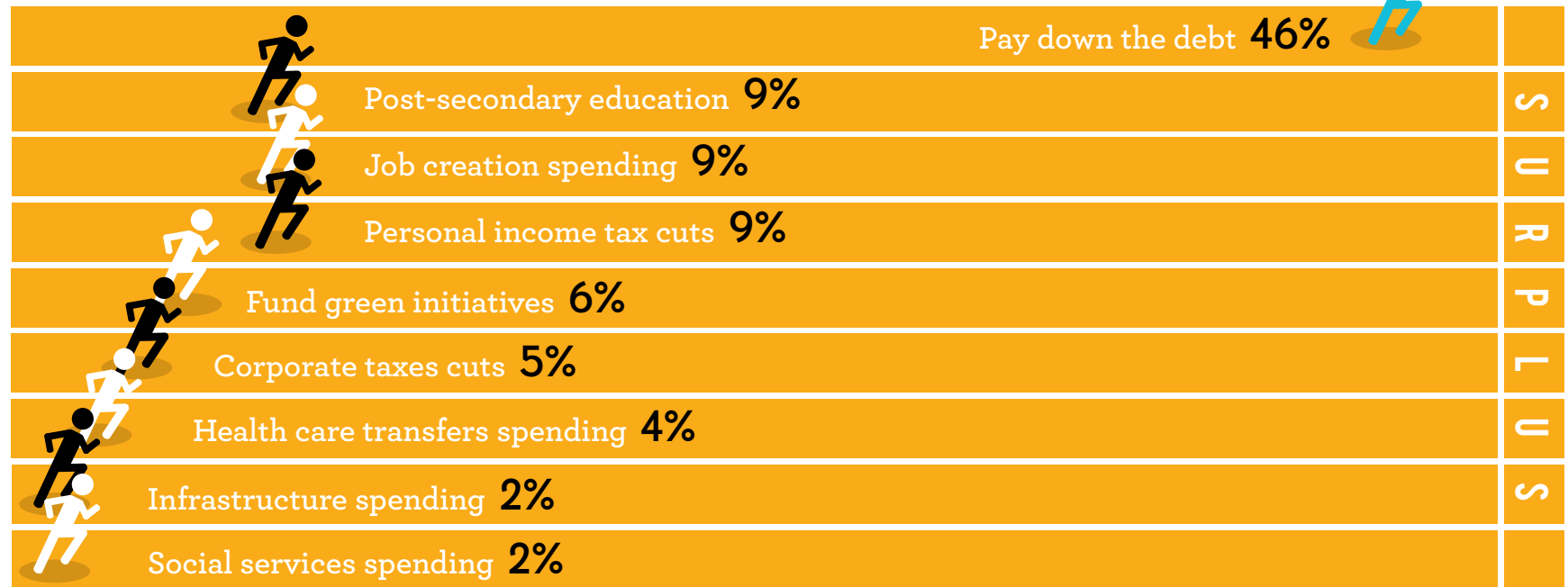

Q: What is the first thing the government should do with the anticipated surplus in 2015?



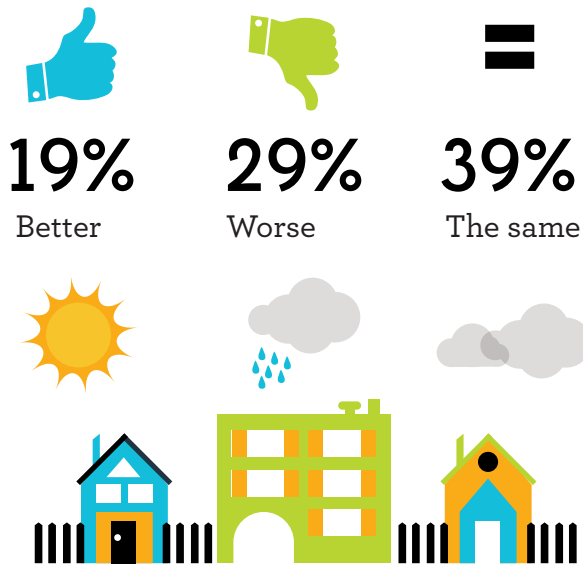
81%

believe the government should place a high priority on reducing the debt as much as possible

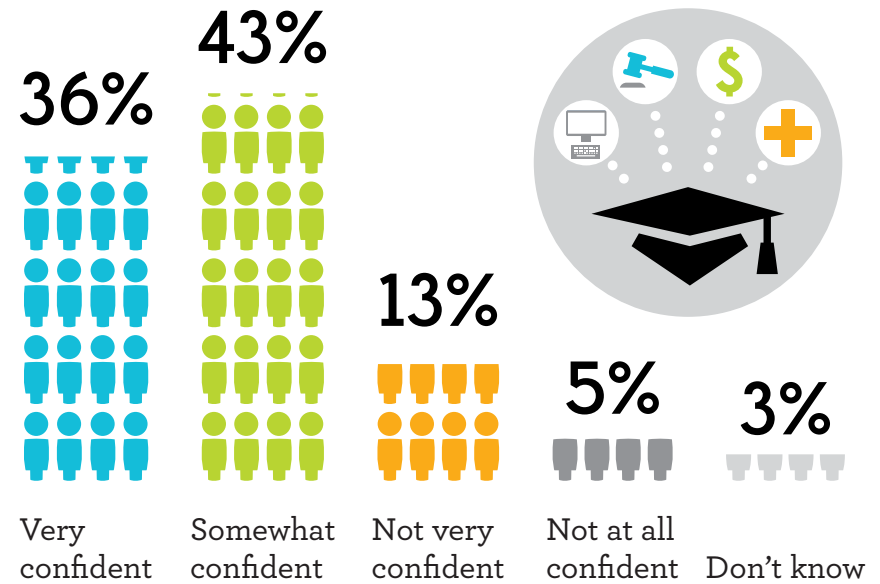


ECONOMIC CONFIDENCE & JOBS

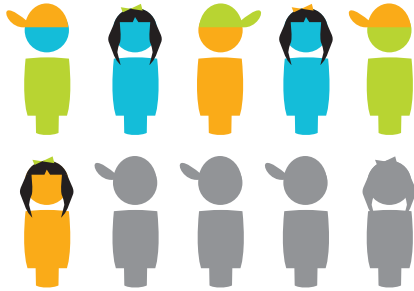

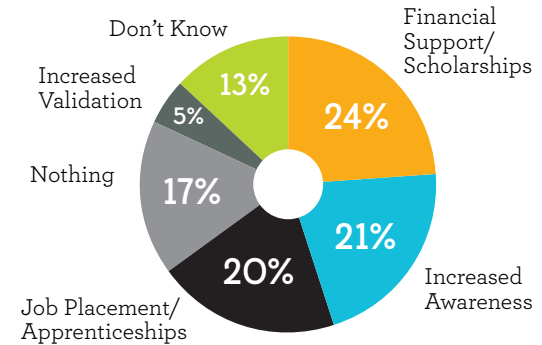

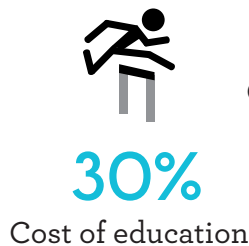

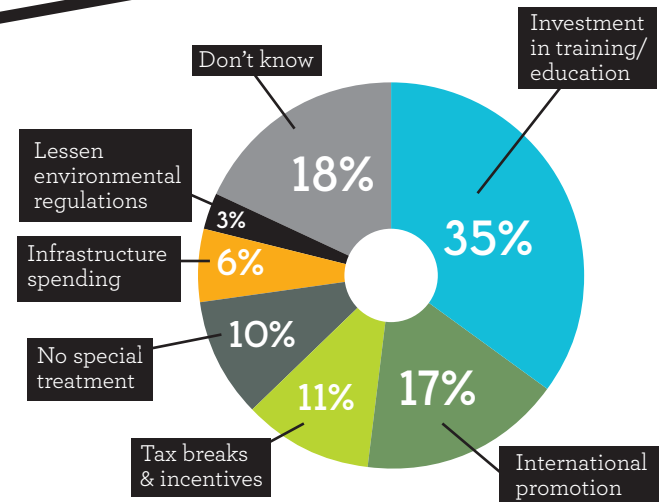

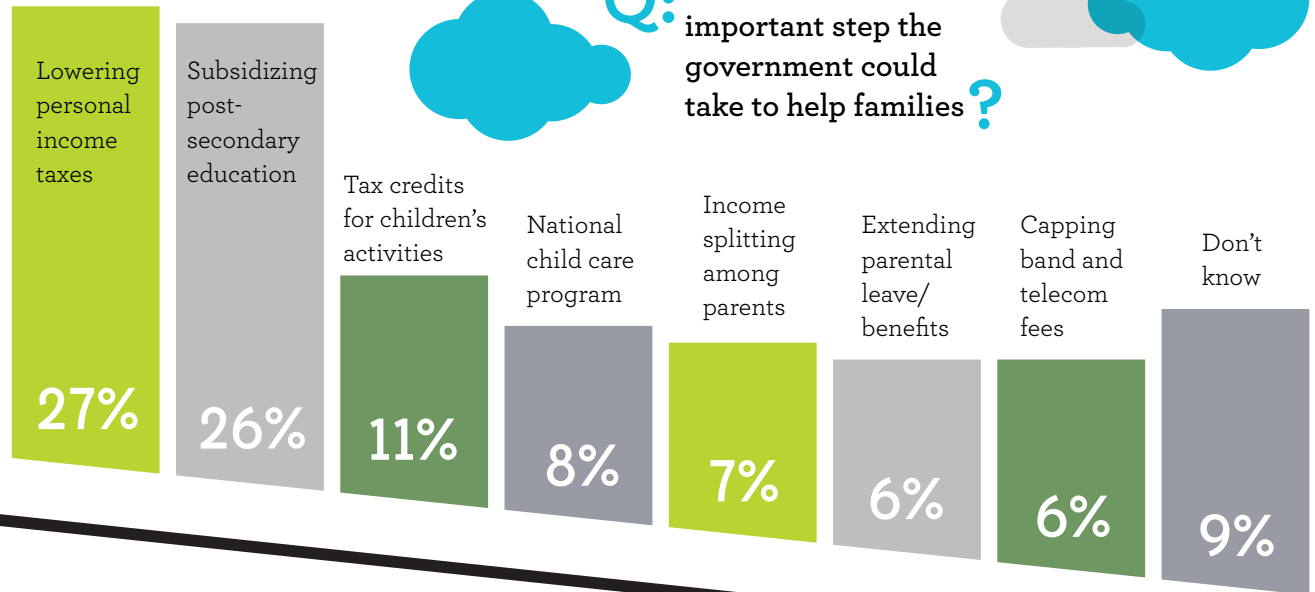

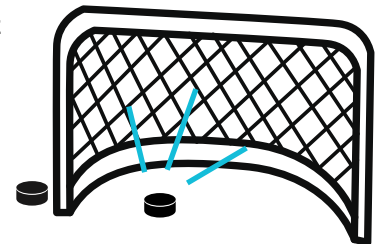


Youth support fitness tax credit for all



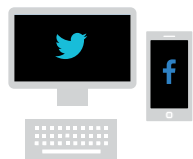
72% support the children's fitness tax credit

Cyberbullying a concern for students...



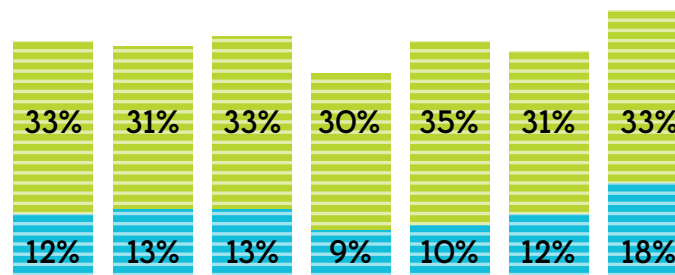
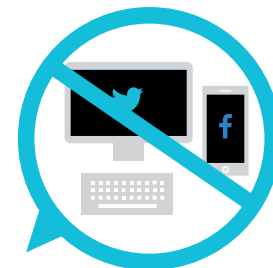
76% say it is a significant problem in Canada
